Electrical Shock Hazard

Disconnect power before servicing. Replace all panels before operating.

Failure to do so can result in death or electrical shock.

NOTE: The neutral drain pack cannot be used in direct-into-spin gearcases.

Retainer Rack/Shoulder Pawl Stud Determination Procedure

 Examine the main drive gear to see if an "X" is marked into it. See Figure 1.



2. If the answer to number 1 is yes, then use new retainer rack and large pawl stud with blue paint dot. See Figure 2.



- 3. If the answer to number 1 is no, then use old retainer rack and small pawl stud (Refer to Figure 3, Rack retainer).
- **4.** After determining which rack retainer and pawl stud should be used, follow installation procedure.



Installation Procedure

- 1. Install spin gear with cam delay spring to spin gear hub in direction shown.
- 2. Install rack retainer using the shoulder pawl stud. (Use rack-stud determination procedure to find out which rack retainer and pawl stud should be used.)
- 3. Install trip lever. The spring of the trip lever MUST rest against the tab on the rack retainer, and trip lever will snap into place.
- 4. Install spin pawl and latch as shown.
